

## Walking Trail 5

Solley's ⇒ Ripple Steam Brewery

(only open by prior appointment)

⇒ The Plough ⇒ Solley's (circular)

**Distance:** 4.5km / 2.75 miles

**Time:** 45 minutes + stopping time at the Brewery & Pub

Start at Solley's Ice Cream Parlour and turn left to follow the drive back out, turn left at the junction. Turn right on to Church Lane continuing past the church and after the last bungalow on the right, take the footpath which runs diagonally across the field.

When you reach the end of the field, go over the stile and follow the path behind the bungalows, turning right on to the pavement. You will approach the crossroads with the village hall on the left hand side and the Victorian school on the right. At the crossroads, turn left (signposted "Martin" & "East Langdon"), following the boundary of the Village Hall around to the right until you pick up the footpath across the field to cross diagonally across the field (South West). Cross the field, then take the steps down on to the road, carrying straight on, passed Sutton Vale Caravan Park on the right. Please be cautious as this is a busy road. After approximately 300m, you will find Parsonage Farm on the right hand side. Brewery located to the side of Parsonage Farm House.

Return up Vale Road, turning left out of the Parsonage Farm drive and back up steps onto footpath across field. When you reach the Village Hall, join the road and turn right at the crossroads, up the hill. Caution, No pavement! Take the next left (approx. 100m) where you will find the Plough pub – perfect for a lunch stop.

To return to Solley's, re-join Chapel Lane (turn right out of the pub then left onto Chapel Lane) continuing up the road until you reach "The Cottage". Take the footpath on the left immediately after "The Cottage" following along the hedge line, then through to the next field. Continue to follow the footpath North, cutting off the corner of the field, before re-joining the hedgerow, going through into the next field towards St Mary the Virgin Church, and following the footpath round to the right. When you re-join the road, turn right continuing back to Solley's to join us for an ice cream sundae for dessert.



Solley's Ice Cream Parlour is open to visitors from Good Friday until the last weekend in September, during which time we are open from 10am - 4pm.

Join us in the Ice Cream Parlour to create your own delicious sundae from our selection of real dairy ice creams, or for the more traditional choose a scoop or two of your favourite flavours to enjoy in a wafer cone.

Tea & coffee are served in the parlour along with light lunches, or why not pick up one of our picnic boxes to enjoy in our picnic area out on the farm trails.

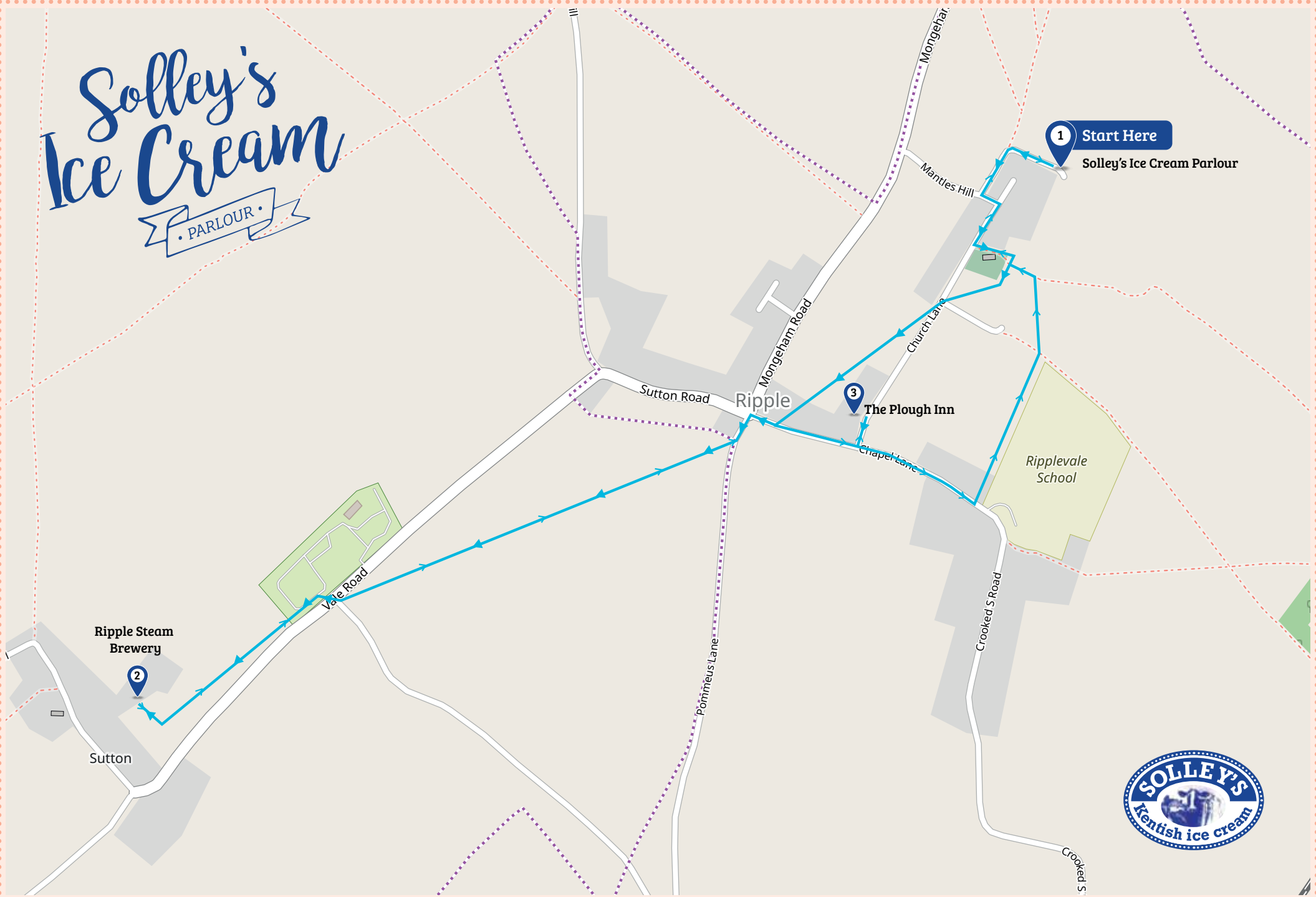
